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The Friends of the Alger Public Library (FrAPL) announce the 5th Annual "SECOND EXPRESSION" Literary Art Show, open to all residents of Hardin County and all students of Hardin County schools. This Art Exhibition and Fundraiser will be held at the USV School Auditeria, November 2, 2019.

Our objectives are to provide visibility and income opportunity for Hardin County artists through an entertaining and interesting art exhibition for the public, and to raise funds to support the library. This show will be based on the theme "SECOND EXPRESSION." The art that is submitted must be representative of recycling unused or unwanted printed library materials as a "SECOND EXPRESSION" of their long life and usefulness. This year we are accepting photography as well. The photo must depict an object that either came from or could have been in a library.

Within the theme of those works selected, we will try to show the best of as many different genres and varied media as possible. It is our hope and intent to display a broad representation of artistic form, style and media to provide the viewer an enjoyable experience at the show.

The judges will consider the following elements of artistic expression:

- 1. Interpretation and clarity of the theme "SECOND EXPRESSION" to the viewer.
- 2. Creativity and originality of the depicted theme.
- 3. Quality of artistic composition and overall design based on the theme.
- 4. Overall impression of the art.

Entry Requirements and Submission Guidelines

All artwork must have been created by the artist submitting the entry form. Artwork must be original, not infringe on any copyright, and be suitable for family viewing.

All artwork should be expected to sell during the Art Sale. The sale price will be established by FrAPL with half of the proceeds going to the artist and half to FrAPL.

Photography submitted must depict an item that could be in a library (Ex: elderly gentleman reading a bible, child reading in the library, etc. Any size is acceptable, but it must be framed and ready to hang.

The artist or his/her representative is required to be present at the event from 4:45 - 7:00pm, November 2, 2019. This will be a special evening, so please dress accordingly.

Entries will be juried based on the overall impression of the piece, including quality, originality, and the listed elements of artistic expression on page #1 of this information packet.

Framed Artwork: When appropriate, accepted artwork needing a frame must be in a professional quality frame and must have hanging wire. Artwork not meeting these standards will not be accepted for the exhibition.

All artwork needing to be hung must be submitted ready to hang with wire.

Each piece of artwork accepted must have the artist's name, contact number, and artwork title, attached to the art with the artwork entry labels on page #4 of this information packet.

The entry form must be clearly legible and filled out completely, including a signature. Any entry forms that are not legible will not be accepted.

There is no restriction on the combination of materials used in your artwork.

Artwork must include original printed work consisting of materials typical of being a library resource (books, magazines, newspapers, maps, ephemera, etc.).

Eligibility

SECOND EXPRESSION is a juried exhibition and fundraiser open to **ALL RESIDENTS OF HARDIN COUNTY** and students of Hardin County schools.
All ages are welcome.

Submissions

All original artwork must be submitted for jurying to the Alger Public Library, 100 W. Wagner St., Alger, OH, on either of the following dates: Friday, October 25, 10:00am - 5:00pm or Saturday, October 26, 10:00am - 1:00pm.

Each entrant will be notified during the week of October 28 as to whether their artwork has been accepted for the exhibition.

All artwork in the exhibition must remain on display for the duration of the show. Any artwork not sold remains the property of Friends of the Alger Public Library. In the event of a future sale, the artist will still receive half of the set price.

Entering artwork gives FrAPL permission to use photos of you and your artwork in future promotions for Second Expression.


